

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY OF STROUD
HELD MAY 22, 2018 AT 5:30 P.M., CITY HALL, STROUD, OKLAHOMA

Item #6. After discussion, Councilor Babinec made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 340 conforming Amount at which competitive bidding is required and amending Section 7-105; Section 7-107 (1) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Stroud, Oklahoma (as Last Codified March 10, 2011); and declaring an emergency, seconded by Councilor Craig. Voting were Smith – aye, Babinec – aye, Garrett – aye and Craig – aye. Motion carried.

Councilor Craig made a motion to declare Ordinance No. 340 an emergency, seconded by Councilor Babinec. Voting were Craig – aye, Garrett – aye, Babinec – aye and Smith – aye.

Item #7. Consideration, discussion and possible action on vision and planning of the future of the City of Stroud. Sherri Gray with GRDA led everyone in identifying a unified vision for the City of Stroud. Things discussed were clean up and beautification, infrastructure, economic development, quality of life, marketing and public relations. No action was taken.
