OKLAHOMA HOUSING FOUNDATION (OHF)

Oklahoma Housing Foundation (OHF) is the Oklahoma-based disaster assistance organization supported by REALTORS® across Oklahoma. OHF offers grants of support to Oklahoma individuals and families who have had their home damaged or have been displaced by a natural disaster.

Type of Assistance: Assistance is available to qualified applicants towards expenses due to disasters.

Eligibility: Recipient must be a full-time resident of Oklahoma and sponsored by a REALTOR®

Disbursement of Funds: In order to provide for a reasonable and equitable distribution of funds, assistance will be provided at a first come, first serve basis. All grants are contingent upon the availability of funds. Grants will be made payable directly to the applicant, unless otherwise specified.

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REALTORS® RELIEF FOUNDATION (RRF)

The REALTORS® Relief Foundation (RRF) is a national organization created by REALTORS® to support communities in their time of need.

Type of Assistance: Assistance is available to qualified applicants towards one of the following options: 1) Monthly mortgage expense for the primary residence that was damaged by the April 27 - May 7 storms impacting 12 Oklahoma counties or; 2) Rental cost due to displacement from the primary residence resulting from the storms or; 3) Hotel reimbursement due to displacement from the primary residence resulting from the storms. Relief assistance is limited to a maximum of \$2,000 per household. Deadline for application submission is July 1, 2024. Please note this assistance is for housing relief only; other expenses including second mortgages (home equity lines or loans), clothing, appliances, equipment, vehicle purchase, rental or repair and or mileage are ineligible for reimbursement under this program.

Eligibility: Recipient must be a full-time resident and U.S. citizen or legally admitted for residence in the United States.

Disbursement of Funds: In order to provide for a reasonable and equitable distribution of funds, assistance will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. All grants are contingent upon the availability of funds.

Attachment Checklist

1. Photo Identification to Show Proof of Residency [i.e.. driver's license or other governmental documentation evidencing residency]
2. Copy of Mortgage Statement or Rent Statement or Lease Agreement or Hotel Receipt
3. One of the Following is Required to Show Proof of Damage to your Primary Residence:
 - o Photos of Damages
 - o Insurance Estimate
 - o Copies of Written Claims, Settlement Proceeds or Claim Status Reports
 - o Copies of Repair Estimates from Contractors

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
